



Dr. Wendy Martinez MD, FACOG, NCMP

Dr. Wendy Martinez is board certified and is a fellow of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology. She received her doctorate in Medicine with honors from Temple University School of Medicine, and completed her residency at Albert Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia, where she also served as Chief Resident. She is also one of only a handful of doctors who is a certified Menopause Practitioner in the state of NJ.

Dr. Martinez has a very successful private practice and has been practicing for over 30 years. She has a very large surgical practice at Virtua, where she is highly respected for her expertise in laparoscopic and laser surgeries, as well as outpatient hysteroscopic removal of polyps and fibroids and vaginal reconstructive surgery for vaginal prolapse. Dr. Martinez also performs cancer surgery, outpatient endometrial thermal ablation for heavy periods and laparoscopic vaginal hysterectomies.

While Dr. Martinez welcomes the opportunity to assist all women with routine obstetrics, she also specializes in High Risk obstetrics. For more than three decades she has cared for pregnant patients with different cancers, thyroid disease, Lupus, asthma, chromosomal alterations, diabetes, hypertension, blood clots and liver and kidney diseases.

When Dr. Martinez founded The Women's Group for Ob/Gyn in 1991, it was the first All-female gynecology and obstetrical practice in Southern NJ - with exclusively female doctors, midwives and nurse practitioners.

Dr. Martinez has served several generations of women and she now treats the daughters of some of her earlier patients and is delivering the babies of women she once delivered. Dr. Martinez is the oldest female physician who is still delivering babies at Virtua Hospital!!!!

An ardent menopause educator, Dr. Martinez has been a member of The North American Menopause Society (NAMS) almost since its inception and is one of only a few physicians representing New Jersey among its members. She has lectured extensively for more than a quarter of a century on osteoporosis, exercise, nutrition, herbal supplements, and hormones empowering women to make smart decisions about their health. She also lectures at several local high schools about sexually transmitted diseases, pregnancy and pregnancy prevention. In addition, she often speaks to breast cancer survivors about their follow up exams and their sexual concerns.

Dr. Martinez has written several articles and is a sought-after national media personality that has appeared on several major networks and radio stations for her expertise, and has been filmed delivering a baby on Lifetime television.

Dr. Martinez has been honored twice for "Woman of the Year" for her exemplary contributions to women's health, and has received Congressional and Senatorial commendations for her leadership and educational efforts. She has been named "Top Ob/Gyn" in southern New Jersey, New Jersey and America, but she is perhaps most proud of being recognized as the Ob/Gyn specialist to whom other doctors would send their own family members.
