AWARENESS TO ACTION: MITIGATING BIAS IN MATERNAL AND INFANT HEALTHCARE™

- Live- An experienced trainer travels onsite (or leads via Zoom) to conduct a one-time, 3-4 hour interactive session with up to 100 learners. (3.5 CNE/CME credits)
- E-learning- Self-paced online training for individual learners. (1.0-1.5 CNE/CME credit)
